The roundtable featured discussions on:

- The pressure AI is placing on traditional billable hour models and litigation workflows
- Practical challenges firms face when moving AI tools from pilot programs into day-to-day practice
- The impact of AI on the development of young attorneys and client and expert engagement

The program included an interactive Q&A format designed to encourage open dialogue among litigators confronting these issues in real time, with participants sharing perspectives on balancing innovation, professional responsibility, efficiency, and client service in an evolving legal environment.
